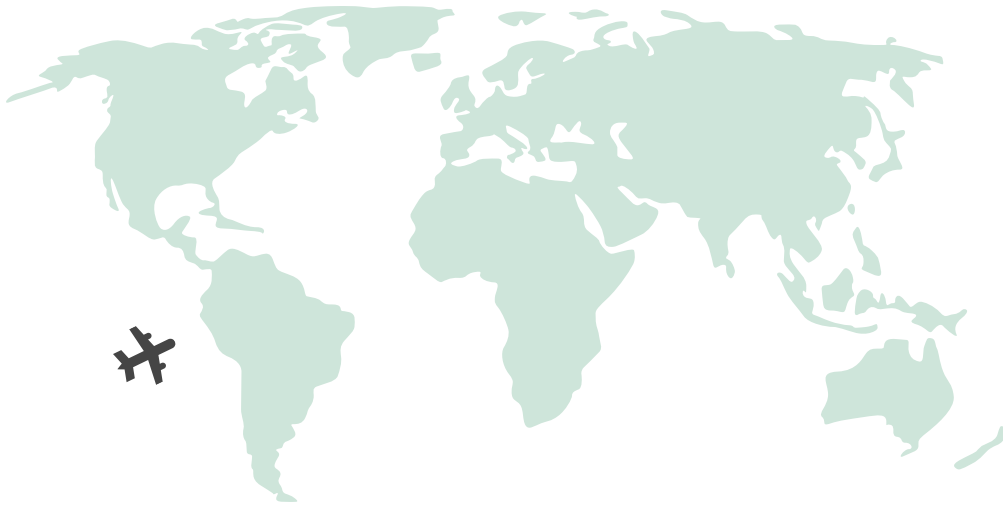


Rely on Global Volunteers' Decades of Expertise
